## African trip Report 2006

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**Monday September 11<sup>th</sup>** we left Cincinnati for Brussels Belgium arriving the 12th. Upon arrival we met with two pastors there. Br. Guido Vanbrabant and Br. Marcus Janckeere and spent the day talking about future ministers meetings in Europe, perhaps in Southern Belgium or France where there is a brother there who will work with us to make these arrangements.. **Wednesday** the 13<sup>th</sup> we left Brussels for Entebbe airport in Uganda where we were picked up by a host of pastors. They dropped us off at the hotel at that night. I have enclosed a picture of the brethren at the hotel. It was very dark because the electric is very poor in those countries.

Accompanying me on this trip were Br. Erling Eriksen from Sweden,, he is wearing the white hat. Next to him is br. Raphael Mbila from Congo, then Br. Desire Mavinga from Congo, then

**Thursday** the 14<sup>th</sup> we left Kampala Uganda and traveled west and south around Lake Victoria arriving in Kigali Rwanda. We held an introductory meeting that night with the ministers that had assembled for these meetings.

There were four Africa countries represented at these meetings with 75 ministers in attendance from Eastern Congo, Rwanda Burundi and South Western Uganda.



Conditions in Rwanda are still very strict and controlled by government which is still concerned about the rebels coming back over the border to kill and destroy as they had done so in the late 90's. If you recall the genocide in Rwanda where the Hutu's purged the Tutsis (800,000 – 1,000,000 people taken from their homes and butchered with cheap Chinese made machetes ) or have sent the movies hotel Rwanda (I highly recommend it) to understand what the believers there have had to put up with this past decade. I received an email just last week that the rebels came into the district

of pastor Bakina Philpis our translator and killed 8 people there.

**Friday** the 15<sup>th</sup> we met with the ministers all day and evening. The meetings were very successful, and the comments were very favorable. There were 75 ministers from Rwanda, Burundi, Congo and Western Uganda. I met Dr. Luc from Goma congo, a very fine brother and a true believer in the Doctrine of Christ. I hope he will travel with us some on our meetings next year. Paul had his Luke the Physician and we shall have ours. Alpha has truly repeated itself in Omega.



**Saturday** the 16<sup>th</sup>, we held a Q & A session with the ministers before setting out for Western Uganda and the city of Rukungiri. The Brothers who traveled with me were assigned a place on the platform and as each question came forth the brothers volunteered to answer them. Truly God gave us some very fine ministers who understand the doctrine very well to travel with us. The ministers in attendance were very thankful for the sessions on the doctrine and went away lifted into heavenly places in Christ Jesus, and a new fervor for the Message of the hour.

**Sunday** the 18<sup>th</sup> we held a couple church meetings for the people and those visiting ministers from Western Uganda who have come down from the mountains for the meetings. Some traveled from as close as the Sudan border. We were blessed to meet them all.



**Monday** the 19<sup>th</sup> we held 2 full sessions that lasted 4 hours each until the evening time with ministers only. Satan tried to interrupt the meetings with a terrific storm and thunder and rain and hail the size of golf balls. The noise was so great on the tin roof you could not hear yourself speak. I sat down and began to pray, and my thoughts were upon a meeting that a Canadian minister had in this country some years ago here the winds had gotten so strong that the roof came down upon the believers and several were killed by the falling sheets of steel. I thought Lord, this cannot happen, and quickly something spoke to me and said, "Have not I sent you here". I said within myself, "yes Lord you did", and that same still voice said, "then take control of the meeting". I then stood up went straight to the pulpit, (less than a minute took place between my leaving the pulpit and reentry to it) I asked the ministers to bow their heads, and spoke to our Father and thanked him for His Word, and then commanded Satan in the name of Jesus Christ to depart. Suddenly, within in seconds, there was silence, no more golf ball size hail beating on the roof. No more winds lifting up on the roof sheets. No more loud thunder and lightning crashing all around us. The sun came out, the winds went away, and all became very calm and peaceful. So calm, in fact that I spoke the next 3 hours without raising my voice to the 35 ministers in attendance.

After service we broke for lunch about 1 p.m. and when we went outside I looked up in the sky



and noticed that the storm was still all around us, but as though a hole in the clouds about 1 mile radius in all directions was above us, and the sun was shining through upon us as though there were no storm at all. But all around us about a mile in each direction those same evil looking storm clouds were raging as before. where we were standing was like an oasis of calm in the midst of a great storm. That afternoon, we again assembled to teach on the Godhead and the storm came back with a vengeance. I again stepped aside to pray, and then something within me said, teach the brothers to do the same as you have done, for

they too are sons of God with the same authority. So I asked the brothers to all bow their heads, and I explained to them that if we say to this mountain be moved and do not doubt it shall be whatsoever we ask. The brothers then prayed for about 5 minutes and as before the storm left us, all was calm, the sun returned and the winds, rain, and hail departed, and again I did not need to lift up my voice to speak to the back of the church.

**Tuesday** the 20<sup>th</sup> we left for Kampala Uganda where we were informed that the 60 ministers we had expected in attendance had grown to 230, this being because three American Ministers had gone around to the churches to convince the brethren not to attend my meetings, saying that I and brother Vayle teach two Gods. So the publicity against worked in our favor and our meetings began with much curiosity among those in attendance, but also it brought with it a mixed multitude as well.



**Wednesday the 21st** we held two 4 hour sessions with the brethren from Kampala Uganda. The atmosphere was very tense and you could have cut it with a knife. The Lord placed a



Sword in my hands, and the Scriptures came forth very rapid like machine gun fire.

**Thursday** the 22<sup>nd</sup> we met all day in Kampala with the ministers again, and this time after the morning meeting, we opened it up for questions. The ministers were told to leave their questions on the platform and we would review them at lunch. We again split up the questions as we had done so in Rwanda, but upon our return from lunch we were informed by several ministers that they had overheard some talking about a trap that had been laid for us with an additional 15 questions we did not have time to prepare for. They figured we would not be able to answer them, and thus go away defeated.



I left those 15 questions on the pulpit and we again held the questions and answers with the brethren myself taking four and distributing the other 8 to the brethren traveling with us. When we finished answering these, I entered the platform again and took the 15 “trap” questions, and one by one the Lord placed the Scriptures in my mind so fast, that as I spoke another scripture would fly from my tongue until all their questions, all 15, were answered in within 5 minutes. When I finished the ministers were dumbfounded at what had just taken place, and the mouths of the unbelievers

were stopped like God shutting the mouth of the hungry lions in Daniels day. *I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have received, unto Him against that day. 2 Timothy 1:12*

**Friday** morning the 23<sup>rd</sup> we left for Eldoret, Kenya where we held a service that evening. I was



sick with fever and Br. Kees VanKlink spoke on The ministry of the Son of Man in this hour.

**Saturday** the 24<sup>th</sup> we met for 2 more meetings of 3-1/2 hours each. Again our Father gave me energy and voice and the 42



ministers in attendance were much blessed by the Presence and the Doctrine of Christ understanding which they received, answering many questions that had plagued them for years concerning the Message.

**Sunday** the 25<sup>th</sup> we spoke at two churches and then addressed Q & A with the ministers.



**Monday** the 26<sup>th</sup> we took a break from our busy schedule and decided to see some wild life in the refuge before returning to Uganda in eastern with the Everywhere told that the really

**Wednesday** we met with the 8 ministers who accompanied us on the trip and assessed the meetings and began planning for next years where the brothers are already arranging meetings in Congo Brazzaville, Gabon and a return trip to Congo DRC. Wednesday night around 2300 hours we began our trek back home through Brussels and then back home America..

As you can see this has been a very busy schedule and we are thankful for your prayers and support you have been so kind to give to us. will need all the energy that God will allot to us, so please continue to pray for the success of these meetings, for our protection, for energy, for strength, and especially for good health.



Truly Africa is a beautiful country with many beautiful spirit filled people, but it also is a place that the devil has a very strong control over the people in general and many of the ministers there. But as you can see the Lord has opened the door for us to teach the Doctrine of Christ to some 1058 ministers so far. Therefore these meeting I believe were very significant in the overall picture for the Elect to come to its realization of their role as obedient sons which is a necessary prerequisite for their adoption.
